Types of Presentations:

OIEA encourages presentations which involve participants in active decision-making, stimulate positive discussions towards improving Indian education and motivate educators to continue their commitment to American Indian/Alaska Native people. Presentations that actively involve students are also encouraged. There will be three session tracks that focus on Early Childhood Education, K-12 Education, and Higher Education. Proposals that focus on these tracks are highly encouraged.

Presentation General Policies:

1. It is the responsibility of the presenter(s) to appear at the annual conference and present the proposed workshop.
