WHEREAS Oregon Indian Education Association has elected a Board to conduct business on behalf of the organization; and,

WHEREAS the Board has adopted policies and procedures relevant to the organization.

THEREBY be it resolved that the governing body of the Oregon Indian Education Association has determined that November be established as Native American Heritage Month in all public schools in the State of Oregon and certain requirements relative to said resolution

THEREBY be it further resolved that the requirements are:

It shall be suggested that all public schools in the State of Oregon recognize and celebrate Native American diversity, and,

Allow Native Americans to continue to make positive contributions and improve our image in our public schools and State, and

Provide opportunities for Native American students to incorporate historical and contemporary perspectives to the general student body on a daily basis during the month of November

Above criteria will be evidenced by submittal of proposal for November as Native American Heritage month to the State of Oregon.
